














Last Call!

While some Jack Frost cocktails lean more towards the tropical side, keep things simple by adding bubbly Prosecco and sweet lemonade to this vodka cocktail. This blended drink has everything one could want in a winter cocktail: it's

frosty, festive, and boozy. Serve it up as your signature Christmas drink, or just to treat yourself after surviving the holiday mayhem.

- 1 cup vodka
- 1 cup Prosecco
- 1/2 cup Blue Curaçao
- 1/2 cup lemonade
- 4 cups ice
- Lemon wedge, for rimming
- White sanding sugar, for rimming
- 1. In a blender, combine vodka, Prosecco, blue curaçao, lemonade, and ice. Blend until combined.
- 2. Run a lemon wedge around the rim of each glass then dip in sanding sugar.
- 3. Pour frosties into rimmed glasses and serve immediately.
- 4. Serves five.
